From 1990 to 2002, Cristina Carrillo worked on supervision of financial institutions, first as an auditor at Price Waterhouse and later as a senior analyst at the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV).

In 2002, Cristina was named Deputy Director of Financial Education of the CNMV, and from 2007 she also took charge of the technical coordination of the permanent working group for the Spanish Nacional Financial Education Strategy, promoted by the Bank of Spain and the CNMV. In 2011 she moved to Argentina and founded Addkeen, a consulting firm that specializes in advice, design, and implementation of financial education and inclusion strategies, both for public and private institutions.
