* The IFIE Americas Chapter Working Group on FC/IE Content Development and Delivery—representing 16 jurisdictions across the Caribbean—is coordinating a video competition: *Young Investors, Creative Expressions - Invest in You!* The competition aims to encourage young investors ages 14-30 to develop a video presentation based on the investor education materials made available by their local IFIE Member. Young investors in each participating jurisdiction can submit a 1-5 minute video that informatively showcases an element of investor literacy. Videos should be submitted to the entrant's local IFIE Member, who will select the local winner(s). Winning videos will also be posted here on the IFIE Global website.
